

How to find us

We have moved to the Portabello Community Centre, on Portabello Road in Wakefield. A map below shows our location, and if you need to use a satnav, the full address and postcode are on the front of this leaflet.



For those on public transport, the Services 59, 96, 97, 105, 106, 195, 196, 485 buses run along the main road (A61), Get off at the first stop after Arriva bus factory, and it is just a short walk up Portabello Road.
